- Provide evidence that Allan Harris has continued to develop his VET knowledge and skills, industry currency and trainer/assessor competence.

- An email confirming that Allan Harris will no longer be training and assessing until fully qualified.

- The RTO's rectification evidence has not demonstrated how Angelo Xerri has continued to develop his trainer/assessor competence.

  - A copy of a current certificate
  - A copy of a current Statement of Attainment

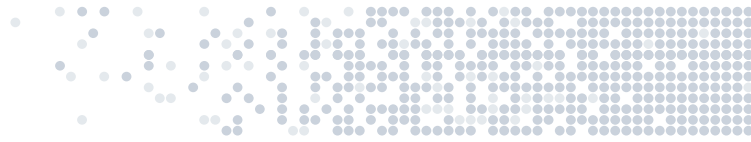
*Reasons for outstanding non-compliance:*

- As per AQF Qualifications Issuance Policy 2.5.5 the Statement of Attainment is not in a form that ensures it cannot be mistaken for a testamur for a full AQF qualification.
- It does not include the statement '**A statement of attainment is issued when as individual has completed one or more accredited units**'

**23.2** The NVR registered training organisation must recognise the AQF and VET qualifications and VET statements of attainment issued by any other RTO.

- The website for Securetraining states "SECUREtraining – offers an extensive list of day courses, diplomas and certificates in security management, defensive tactics, first aid and many more". Securetraining is not approved to deliver any diploma level security courses.

*In order to become compliant, the organisation is required to:*

- Amend its website to portray information which aligns to the approved scope of registration.

*Analysis of rectification evidence:*

The following evidence was sighted:

- Provider's website <http://securecorp.com.au/training/>
- The RTO has provided evidence to demonstrate that it has amended its website to be aligned to their scope of registration.
- The RTO has added their registration number to the name on the website and removed references for training that is no longer on scope.
- The RTO is now compliant with this standard.
